

## District of Columbia's Home and Community-Based Services Promoting Interoperability Program TRACK 1 ATTESTATION CHECKLIST

All provider organizations that participate in the Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Promoting Interoperability (PI) Program are required to submit supporting documentation to validate attested milestones. All supporting documentation used during the attestation must be retained for at <u>least six years</u>. Supporting documentation is to be submitted via <u>DC's State Level Registry</u> (https://dcslr.thinkhts.com/).

**Track 1** is appropriate for HCBS provider organizations that have not yet adopted certified EHR technology in their practice. Track 1 provider organizations will receive technical assistance to acquire, purchase or secure access to certified EHR technology. Additionally, technical assistance will support and assist with the installation or commence utilization of EHR technology.
