

## <u>District of Columbia's Home and Community-Based Services</u> <u>Promoting Interoperability Program</u> TRACK 2 ATTESTATION CHECKLIST

All provider organizations that participate in the Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Promoting Interoperability (PI) Program are required to submit supporting documentation to validate attested milestones. All supporting documentation used during the attestation must be retained for at <a href="Least six years">Least six years</a>. Supporting documentation is to be submitted via <a href="DC's State Level Registry">DC's State Level Registry</a> (<a href="https://dcslr.thinkhts.com/">https://dcslr.thinkhts.com/</a>).

**Track 2** is appropriate for HCBS provider organizations that need to upgrade to certified EHR technology in their practice. Track 2 organizations will receive technical assistance to update and expand the functionality of certified EHR technology.
